Message Text: John 1:19-34

Message Title: Nothing to Prove

Big Idea: You've nothing to prove, just a person to whom you point.

Questions:

1. Who is someone you know who is confident within themselves? Why do you think they are that way?
2. Read John 1:19-28. What was John the Baptist's demeanor while the Jewish leaders questioned him? What do you notice about the answers He gives about who He is?
3. What was the meaning behind John's message for the Jewish leaders (see Isaiah 40:1-5)?
4. Why is knowing who you are not just as important as knowing who you are?
5. How do you become sure of who you are as one chosen by God?
6. Who have you tried to emulate in your life? How might trying too hard to be like someone else make you miss out on what God has for you specifically?
7. In what area of your life do you get stressed by the need to perform or feel unsure of who you are? How can recognizing you are chosen by God and, in turn, pointing to Jesus help free you from those things?
